- ✓ **To improve the first point, we must address the latter two**



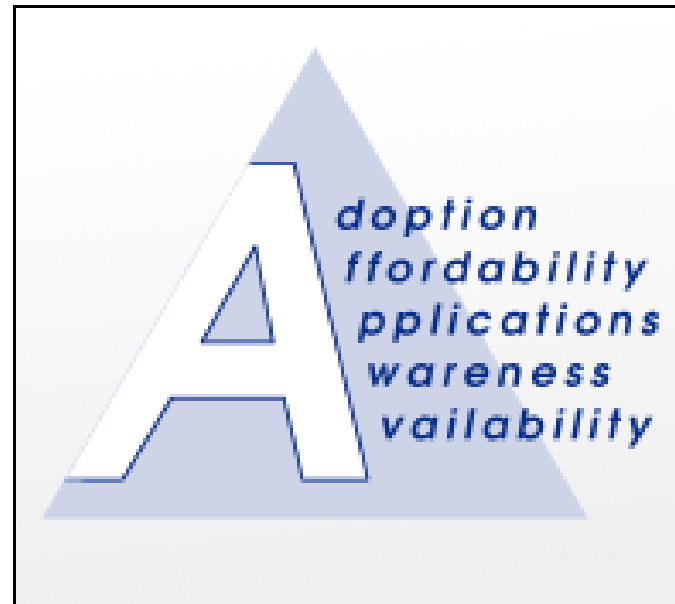
Governor Fletcher's "Prescription for Innovation"

A “Grassroots” Effort

- 1) Inventory of local broadband service availability
- 2) Community Assessment (with local leadership team)
 - K-12, healthcare, small business, agriculture, local government, etc.
- 3) Gap Analysis / Business Planning / Funding Assistance
- 4) Infrastructure Expansion Project Management
 - Working with providers and local leadership
- 5) Community Awareness/Adoption
 - Provide a meaningful online presence for every Kentucky community to facilitate citizen services and encourage demand
